

# Terms and conditions for the provision of digital certificates (hereinafter referred to as SSL Certificates)

The following terms and conditions govern the details for the provision and management of SSL Certificates. These terms and conditions are valid only as an integral part of the General Contractual Terms.

#### SSL Certificate

An SSL/TLS certificate is a digital certificate issued by a trusted certificate authority (CA). SSL/TLS protocol allows you to secure communication by encrypting and authenticating the communicating parties.

## I. The Contracting Parties

The contracting parties are INTERNET CZ, a. s. on the one side as the Provider (hereinafter referred to as the Provider) and the Customer of the services on the other side (hereinafter referred to as the Customer). The Contracting Parties are further specified in Article I. of the General Contractual Terms.

#### II. Basic Arrangements

SSL certificate can be ordered only for a fixed period of time, according to the terms and conditions of the CA.

The Customer is obliged to provide the Provider with his/her complete and true contact details and to keep them up to date.

The Provider is entitled to transfer Customer data to the relevant CA based on the Customer's agreement to these terms and conditions.

Customer agrees to familiarize themselves with the rules of the relevant CA (see Section V. Related Documents)

Customer acknowledges and understands that the SSL/TLS certificate is not a stand-alone service and its use requires professional installation.

During the subscription period, the domain name for which the certificate is issued cannot be changed.

# III. Setting up an SSL certificate

- 1) The Customer orders an SSL Certificate through the Provider's Interface or other means by which the Provider enables the Customer to place its order.
- 2) The order process may require the use of other websites, forms or other means defined by the Provider for this purpose.
- 3) The Customer follows the Provider's instructions and cooperates with the CA, especially during the validation of the applicant.

# IV. SSL Certificate Renewal

- 1) Renewal of an SSL certificate means the expiration of the original SSL certificate and the issuance of a new SSL certificate; therefore, the same arrangements as in Section III. Setting up an SSL certificate apply.
- 2) 30 days before the expiration of the SSL certificate, the Provider will issue a request for payment of the next period and send it to the Customer's billing e-mail.
